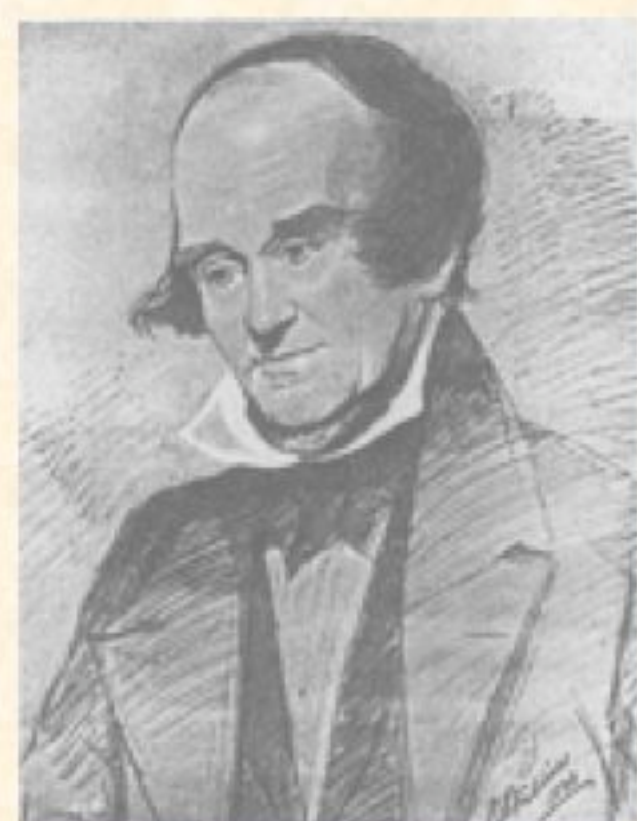
Lancaster Quay, named for the educator **Joseph Lancaster**
